How to get there

Stary Port and Klub pod Jaszczurami are located in Krakow's Old Town.

- There is a limited traffic zone in the Old Town - limited access by car*
- Within walking distance of St. Mary's Basilica.

Dworek Białoprądnicki is located in Prądnik Biały district, 4 km north of the city centre.

- **Car *:** Parking is available near Dworek, but space may be limited during rush hour.
- **Public transit:** Convenient access by tram (*Białoprądnicka* stop) and bus (*Mackiewiczza* and *Szpital Jana Pawła II* stops).
 - From Kraków Główny station: take tram 50 to *Białoprądnicka* stop. Alternatively you can take buses 105, 405 to *Opolska Estakada* stop, then 138, 169, 172 to *Mackiewiczza*.
- **Bike:** There are dedicated bike paths in the area, allowing easy ride to the city centre and neighboring districts.

***If you're traveling to Kraków by car** mind the city's Low Emission Zone (see [guide](#)).

You can check if your car meets the requirements and pay to enter the zone at sct.zdmk.krakow.pl.

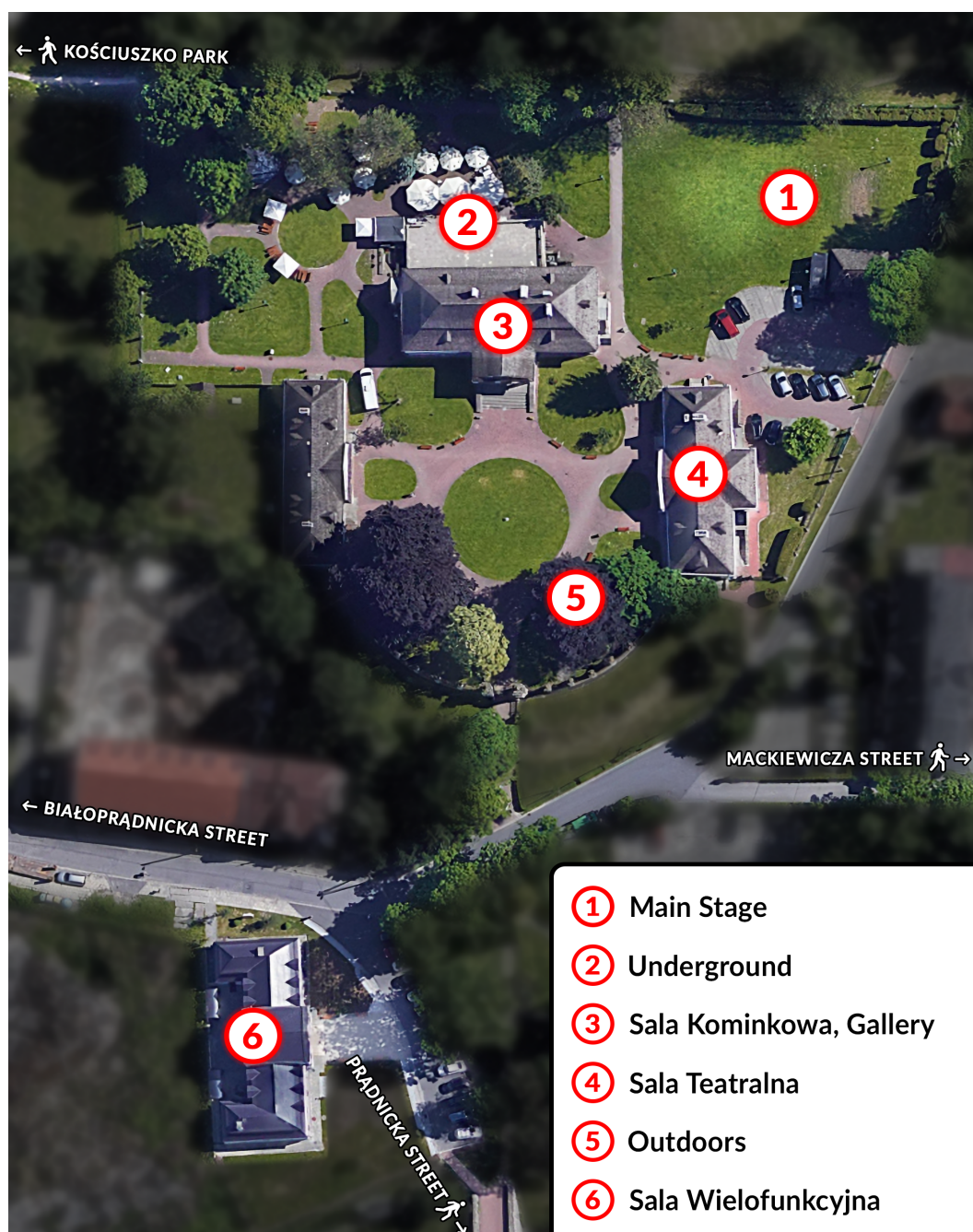

Additional attractions

Wistlas Touta Reenactors' Village

Operating since 2025, Wistlas Touta is a historical reenactment project engaged in recreating the ancient history of present-day Silesia, Lesser Poland and Subcarpathia, with particular emphasis on the upper Vistula basin.

The group specialises in the Late La Tène period (La Tène D), which saw a clear blend of prospering Celtic culture with the increasingly influential Germanic cultures.

The group will also give a demonstration of Celtic weaponry and clothing (Saturday 14:30, Main Stage) and a reenactment titled "The Legend of the Celts' Arrival at the Vistula" (Saturday 16:00, Main Stage)

Image, Object, Word Exhibition

The exhibition's starting point is the question of the boundaries between visual arts, text, crafts, and folklore – do such boundaries actually exist, and if so, how can they be crossed nowadays? The exhibition aims to be a space for dialogue between the past and the present, between locality and Celtic cultures, and between different ways of telling stories.

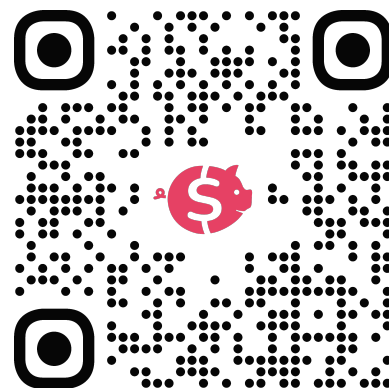
